ORAL ORDER

2. 13-08-2021 Heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

This is 2nd attempt for grant of bail. Earlier, the bail application of petitioner was rejected by this Court, vide order dated 08.12.2020 passed in Cr.Misc. No. 25177 of 2020 with following observation:

“Looking to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the manner in which the counterfeit notes were tried to be delivered in the country, which will cause harm to the financial position of the court, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for bail is rejected for the present.”

It is submitted on behalf of petitioner that subsequently, co-accused Md. Afroz, who was driving the alleged motorcycle, of which, petitioner was pillion rider, has already been granted bail by the court below itself, vide order annexed as Annexure – 3 to the bail petition. It is further



submitted that in this case, chargesheet has already been submitted and thereafter, cognizance has been taken. Petitioner has got clean antecedent and he is in custody since 07.01.2020.

Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as period of custody, the bail petition of petitioner is allowed. Let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate VI, Araria in connection with Jogbani (Bathnaha) P.S. Case No. 04 of 2020, on the following conditions:

“(1) Petitioner shall cooperate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court below and shall remain physically present, as directed by the court below, and on his absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his bail-bond shall be cancelled by the court below.

(2) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.”
