2 01-11-2021 The present writ petition has been filed seeking quashing of the order dated 1.5.2020 passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Masaurhi whereby and whereunder the license of the PDS shop of the petitioner bearing license no. 55/2016 has been cancelled.

At the outset, the learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner, Sri N.K.Agrawal, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to prefer an appeal under Rule 32(iii) of the Bihar Targeted Public Distribution System (Control) Order, 2016.
