3 07-12-2021 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner has prayed for the following relief:-

“I. Quashing the decision of the insurance Company contained in letter dated 10.10.2019(Annexure-5), issued by the respondent numbers 4 and 5 and granting only Rs. 6,12,000/- towards claim of the petitioner on total loss basis under policy number **333101/31/2018/8812**;

II. Commanding the respondents to pay the petitioner total value of the insured vehicle amounting to Rs. 8,45,000/- under the aforesaid policy and interest on

this amount at the rate of 14% per annum from the date of accident till the date of payment.”

After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this petition with liberty to approach the appropriate/competent forum for redressal of his grievances as permissible in law.

This application is dismissed as withdrawn reserving liberty to the writ petitioner to take recourse to such remedies as are otherwise available in accordance with law.
