2 22-10-2021 Let the defect (s) be removed within two weeks of
the complete start of the physical Court.

Heard the parties in virtual Court.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 3/4 of the Mahua Flower
Act.

Allegation is of recovery of Mahua Flower. Petitioner
has got no criminal antecedent. Investigation of the case is
already complete.

Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of
Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like
amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where
the case is pending in connection with Amarpur Police Station



Case No.78 of 2021 corresponding to Special Excise Case
No.100 of 2021 with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be resident of territorial
jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the trial
of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to
cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without
permission of the trial Court.
