2 28-07-2021 Heard Mr. Sunil Prasad Singh, learned counsel for

the petitioner and Mr. Ganesh Prasad, Additional Public

Prosecutor for the State through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Bajpatti PS Case No. 53/2019 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 147, 341, 323, 324, 447, 379, 307,
326(K), 354(B) and 506 of the IPC.

This is the second attempt for bail made on behalf of
petitioner inasmuch as earlier bail application of the petitioner
was rejected *vide* Cr. Misc. No. 24158/2020 dated 25.11.2020
(Annexure-1) with liberty to renew her prayer for bail after
three months.

The allegation against the petitioner, as per First
Information Report, is that she threw acid on the informant as a
result of which, she sustained burn injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that both



parties are co-sharers and there was previous dispute between them. Learned counsel further submits that the injuries caused to the grand daughter of the informant are simple in nature and the petitioner is in custody since 04.02.2020.

Having regard to the submissions made by the parties and taking into consideration the material on record and the petitioner is in custody since 04.02.2020, charge-sheet has already been submitted in the matter and this is the second attempt for bail by the petitioner, I am inclined to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, let the petitioner, RIJWANA KHATOON @ RIZWANA KHATOON be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Pupri at Sitamarhi in connection with Bajpatti PS Case No. 53/2019.

It is made clear that at the time of furnishing bail bonds all the parties shall follow the covid protocol like social/physical distancing and sporting masks.
