ORAL ORDER

2 01-02-2021 Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove the defects, as pointed out by the office, within a period of four weeks.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The present application has been filed for modification of the order dated 31.10.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 42402 of 2018, by which the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 267 of 2016, pending in the court of learned A.C.J.M.-II, Danapur, Patna, and the petitioner was directed to surrender in the court below within a period of six weeks and furnish bail bond.



Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to some unavoidable reasons the petitioner could not surrender in the court below well within time. It is prayed on behalf of the learned counsel for the petitioner that further time may be extended so that the petitioner could surrender in the court below and furnish bail bond.

Considering the submissions made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner and the grounds mentioned in the modification application, the period of surrender of the petitioner in the court below is extended for a further period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order. The rest of the conditions stipulated in the order will be same.

The order dated 31.10.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 42402 of 2018, is modified to the extent as indicated above.

The present application is disposed of.
