2 17-12-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State through virtual mode.

Counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove the defect(s), as pointed out by the office, within a period of eight weeks.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Malaypur P.S. case No.102 of 2020 registered under Sections 147, 341, 323, 354(B), 307, 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that the petitioner gave bhujali blow over the head of Chanda Singh, due to which Chanda Singh sustained head injury.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that there is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against



the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. The nature of injury is said to be simple, which is apparent from the order of the learned Sessions Court. Hence, no offence under Section 307 of the I.P.C. is made out. It is a case and counter case between the parties. Free fight is alleged to have taken place. The injuries on the side of the accused persons have not been explained by the prosecution. The prosecution has not come with clean hands.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the complaint case/F.I.R.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Jamui in connection with Malaypur P.S. case No.102 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
