This appeal is directed against the judgment/order dated 08.04.2021 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 8879 of 2020, titled as Vijay Shankar Prasad @ Vijay Shankar Chandravanshi Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors., by a learned Single Bench of this Court.

In view of the disputed questions of fact with regard to right and title, as has been so held by the learned Single Judge, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned



order dated 08.04.2021 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 8879 of 2020,
