This is an application seeking quashing of the F.I.R. of Motihari Town P.S. Case No. 356 of 2015 dated 10.06.2015 instituted for the offences under Sections 498A of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 /4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

On 04.11.2020, notice was issued to opposite party no. 2 for her appearance before this Court on 13.01.2021.

It appears from the office notes that requisites for notice has also not been filed.

It appears that the petitioners have lost interest in the matter.
