The petitioner is in custody in connection with S.T.
No. 530 of 2019, arising out of Jamalpur P.S. Case No. 54 of
2019, for the offence under Section 302 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Considering the materials available on record, the
Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly,
his prayer for grant of bail is rejected.

The trial court is directed to expedite the trial and
conclude the same in all respect within a period of six months
from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Darbhanga is
directed to take steps for production of all prosecution witnesses
for their examination, so that the trial may be concluded within



the time indicated herein above.

In the event, the trial is not concluded within the aforesaid period, the petitioner shall be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail.
