Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Vaishali P.S. Case No. 96
of 2021, registered for the offence punishable punishable under
Sections 272, 273 and 414 of the Indian Penal Code and section
30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

45 litres of foreign liquor has been recovered from the
house of this petitioner.

It is submitted that no recovery has been made from
conscious possession of this petitioner. Recovery has been made
from the house which is in joint possession of family member.
Petitioner is in custody since 19.03.2021 having no criminal



antecedent, as stated in para 3 of the petition. Investigation is complete.

Considering the period of custody coupled with the fact that petitioner bears clean antecedent, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge Excise Court, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Vaishali P.S. Case No. 96 of 2021, subject to following conditions:-

(i) The petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reasons, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the court below.

(ii) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
