2 18-01-2021 Heard counsel for the petitioner and counsel
appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in connection with Mehsi P.S. Case No. 323 of 2019 for offences under Sections 363, 366A, 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He refers to the statement of the victim under Section 164 Cr.P.C. as contained in Annexure-2 to contend that the victim has voluntarily joined the wedlock with the petitioner.

Considering the statement of the victim under Section 164 Cr.P.C and also the fact that the victim is adult and she has every right to join wedlock on her own choice, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner, above



named, in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the ACJM, Champaran, Motihari in connection with Mehsi P.S. Case No. 323 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C.
