Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Let the defect(s), if any, be removed within four weeks after complete start of the physical Court.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Specific allegation of commission of firearm injury and death as well as of firing is against FIR named accused persons. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. Similarly situated some other co-accused Man Mohan Singh and Abhay Singh have already been allowed anticipatory bail by different coordinated Benches of this Court vide orders at Annexure-2.

Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the



learned Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Magadh Medical Police Station Case No. 77 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:-

(a) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the learned court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(b) Both the bailors shall be resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the learned trial court.
