9 05-02-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Raniganj P.S. Case No.288 of 2019 (G.R. No.3057 of 2019)
for the offence punishable under Sections 363 and 365 of the
Indian Penal Code. Subsequently, Sections 302, 201, 120B of
the Indian Penal Code has been added.

The allegation in the prosecution case is that the
informant's son has been done to death by the petitioner and
his family members as he was maintaining an amorous
relationship with the petitioner's daughter.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that beyond
suspicion, there is no basis for the petitioner's implication. It
is further submitted that the petitioner is now in custody for



about a year i.e., since 28.01.2020.

The learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail. It is submitted that in the investigation and as per the prosecution case, very strong circumstances have led to the petitioner's implication. The manner in which the victim has been done to death is very heinous as the body parts have been recovered from three different places.

Considering the rival submissions, this Court, for the present, is not inclined to allow the prayer for bail. The same is rejected.

This Court would expect that the petitioner's counsel would honour his undertaking in the instant proceedings regarding supply of the requisite court fee etc. within two weeks from the date he is called upon to do so by the office.
