Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to remove defect(s), as pointed out by the office, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Tisiauta P.S. Case No. 21 of 2021 for the offence punishable under Sections 272 and 273/34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 36 of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this bail application on behalf of petitioner no.2, above named.

Accordingly, this bail application is dismissed as withdrawn as against petitioner no.2, above named.



The petitioner no.1 is the wife of petitioner no.2 and being the wife is not expected to join the illegal business of her husband.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner no.1, above named, in the event of her his arrest/surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, II-cum-Excise Court, Excise, Vaishali at Hajipur, in connection with Tisiauta P.S. Case No. 21 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
