4 28-10-2021 Though, the present petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 02.11.2016 passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Hajipur, whereby and where under, the P.D.S. license of the petitioner bearing License No.63 of 2007 has been cancelled as also for quashing the appellate order dated 04.09.2019, but the learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, seeks liberty to prefer a revision petition under Clause 32(vi) of the Bihar Targeted P.D.S.
