Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the respondents through video conference. Learned counsel for the petitioner hereby undertakes that all the defects pointed out by the stamp reporter shall be removed, and compliance with the conditions of the notices of this Court with regard to acceptance of e-filing shall be made, without delay immediately upon resumption of normal physical functioning of the Court, and in any event within one month thereof.



2. Mr. P.K. Shahi, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that in view of the contract having been awarded to a third party, the matter need not be pressed any further. He makes a request for consequential refund of the earnest money of the petitioner.
