Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in connection
with Special Excise Case No. 474 of 2019 arising out of
Dhamdaha P.S. Case No. 194 of 2019 registered for the offence
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act.

In view of the fact that *prima facie* a case under the
Excise Act, is made out against the petitioner, this application
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is not maintainable
in view of Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in the case
of *Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar* reported in *2019(2)*
P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.).



Accordingly, this anticipatory bail application is
dismissed as not maintainable.
