6 21-01-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel appearing for the State.

At the outset, it is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the issue, raised in the writ application, has already been decided by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 22-07-2019 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 4286 of 2018. It is also submitted that during pendency of the writ petition, respondents have taken a decision to terminate the services of petitioners. Termination order contained in Memo No. 24 dated



11-10-2019, has been brought on record vide Annexure 11 to I.A.No.1/2019.

Learned counsel for the State respondents does not dispute the aforesaid facts and raises no objection.

Accordingly, this writ application is allowed in terms of order dated 22-07-2019 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 4286 of 2018. Order of termination dated 11.10.2019 (Annexure 11 to I.A.No.1/2019) is quashed. Respondents are directed to reinstate the petitioners with all consequential benefits.
