4 16-07-2021 The present petition has been taken up for consideration through the mode of Video conferencing in view of the prevailing situation on account of COVID 19 Pandemic, requiring social distancing.

The learned counsel for the Respondent-Bihar Medical Services and Infrastructure Corporation Ltd. (Respondents No. 5 to 8), Sri Rana Vikram Singh, Advocate submits that the tender in question has already been granted to the petitioner firm and a LOI in that regard has also been issued, thus the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
