ORAL ORDER

2 22-10-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State through video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks bail in Bypass P.S. Case No. 150
of 2021, registered for the offence punishable punishable under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2018.

330.105 litres of foreign liquor has been recovered
from Magic van which were kept in sack.

It is submitted that no recovery has been made from
conscious possession of this petitioner. Petitioner is neither
driver nor owner of the vehicle in question and he has got no
concern with the seized liquor. Petitioner is in custody since
03.05.2021 having no criminal antecedent, as stated in para 3 of
the petition. Investigation is complete.

Considering the period of custody coupled with the



fact that petitioner bears clean antecedent, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge Excise Court, Patna in connection with Bypass P.S. Case No. 150 of 2021, subject to following conditions:-

(i) The petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates without sufficient reasons, his bail bond shall be liable to be cancelled by the court below.

(ii) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
