2 29-06-2021 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“(i) For a direction upon the Respondents to continue the scheme of distribution of Supplementary Nutrition (SN) to malnourished children as per the scheme and guidelines given by the Central Government to the State Government and not to substituted it by Direct Bank Transfer (SBT) of money in the account of the parent of children as it would defeat the very



objective of strengthening a person from the childhood.

(ii) For an order, direction or appropriate writ commanding the respondents to provide the benefit of Supplementary Nutrition (SN) to the migrant labourers who have returned to their villages falling in different Anganbari Centres in Bihar and have been linked in the portal of Social Welfare Department as beneficiary.

(iii) Any other order/orders for which the petitioner is found entitled to in the facts and circumstances of the present case.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition for the reason that with the passage of time the same has become infructuous.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

However, liberty reserved to raise the issue before the appropriate authority as and when such occasion arises.
