ORAL ORDER

2 08-10-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, some unknown miscreants, on the point of pistol, snatched the motorcycle of the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case on the basis of his criminal antecedent. Petitioner's name has figured during course of investigation. No incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Test Identification Parade has not been carried out till date. He is in custody since 21.3.2021.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, mentioned above, be enlarged on bail on



furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in Bachhwara Police Station Case No. 248 of 2020 on the following conditions:-

(1) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be properly represented on each and every date fixed by the Court and shall remain physically present as directed by the Court and on his/her absence on two consecutive dates without sufficient reason, his/her bail bond shall be cancelled by the Court below.

(2) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses, in that case, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.
