the complete start of the physical Court.

Heard the parties.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363,366A,34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 8 and 10 of the POCSO Act.

The impugned order reveals that the victim stated in her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. that she had voluntarily left her house. In spite of that statement, the court below refused prayer for bail on the ground of seriousness of the allegation.

Since there is no allegation against the petitioner by the victim and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or



surrender before the court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000 (Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Patahi P.S.Case No.74 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the learned Trial Court.
