ORAL ORDER

2 01-10-2021 The instant case has been taken up for consideration through the mode of Video conferencing in view of the prevailing situation on account of COVID 19 Pandemic, requiring social distancing.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri Sanjay Kumar, learned AC to GA 13 appearing for the State.

The present writ petition has been filed seeking following reliefs :-

“(i) For issuance of an appropriate writ in



the nature of mandamus for commanding and directing the respondent authorities concerned to allow the petitioner to conduct proper functioning of Public Distribution System's shop of Ramgarha PACS, Block Daraunda, District- Siwan as Manager of Ramgarha PACS, Block Daraunda, District- Siwan without any hindrance.

(ii) For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for commanding and directing the respondent authorities concerned to allow the petitioner to continue as Manager of Ramgarha PACS, Block Daraunda, District-Siwan without any hindrance on the ground that the petitioner has regularly distributed the food grains as well as Kerosene oil.

(iii) For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for commanding and directing the respondent authorities concerned to pass an appropriate and speaking order on the representations of the petitioner filed before the authorities concerned."

The learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to file appropriate representation before the Sub-Divisional Officer, Maharajganj,



Siwan for redressal of his aforesaid grievances.

The learned counsel for the respondent State
has got no objection.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands
disposed of as not pressed, however with liberty to the petitioner
to file appropriate representation regarding his aforesaid
grievances before the Sub-Divisional Officer, Maharajganj,
Siwan and in case, such a representation is filed within a period
of four weeks from today, the same shall be considered and
disposed of, in accordance with law, within a period of eight
weeks,thereafter.
