The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No.697C/2017 for offences under Sections
420/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is being submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioners that this case is purely of land dispute and now the
grievance of the complainant has also been redressed.

Considering the aforesaid fact, the application for
anticipatory bail is allowed.
