Ms. Anita Kumari Singh, the learned APP for the State.

The present petition is by way of third attempt at
the behest of the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with
Amarpur PS case no. 527 of 2017 instituted for the offences
punishable under Section 304B/34 of Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is alleged to have killed his wife
on account of non fulfilment of the demand for dowry.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has
submitted that the petitioner is innocent, he has been falsely
implicated in the present case, he is having a clean antecedent
and he is languishing in custody since 22.10.2017, hence some
time may be fixed for conclusion of the trial.

Per contra, the learned A.P.P. for the State has



vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the period of incarceration of the petitioner, I deem it fit and proper to direct the learned court of 1st Additional Sessions Judge, Banka in connection with Amarpur PS case no. 527 of 2017, to conclude the trial within a period of 12 months from today.

It is needless to state that in case, the trial is not concluded within a period of 12 months from today, the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court for renewal of his prayer for bail.

The present petition stands disposed off as not pressed, however with the aforesaid directions and liberty.
