2 30-11-2021 Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to remove all the defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter within one month.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is plaintiff before the court below in Title Suit No. 190 of 2009. She has filed a petition for interim injunction under



Order 39, Rules 1 and 2 of the Civil Procedure Code (hereinafter to be referred to as 'the Code') on 20.09.2016, but still that petition has not been disposed of after a lapse of near about five years.

In view of aforesaid, the learned court below is directed to dispose of the petition filed on behalf of the petitioner/plaintiff under Order 39, Rules 1 and 2 of the Code within a period of three months, if it has not already been disposed of.

With this direction/observation, this civil miscellaneous application is disposed of.

Office shall ensure that all defects are removed by the petitioner within the stipulated time provided in para 1 hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
