2 01-11-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 457, 380/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the prosecution case, while the informant had gone to Goa, petitioner and other accused persons committed theft in his house and looted Rs.5,80,000/0 and jewelery.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case on the basis of suspicion. Petitioner happens to be nephew of the informant and there was some dispute between them. No incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has claimed clean antecedent and he is in custody since 21.4.2021.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. Let the petitioner, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in Bodhgaya Police Station Case No. 139 of 2021.
