APP for the State through video conference.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed an undertaking that all defects pointed out by the stamp reporter shall be removed, and compliance with the conditions of the notices of this Court with regard to acceptance of e-filing shall be made, without delay immediately upon resumption of normal physical functioning of the Court, and in any event within one month thereof.

3. The petitioner, who is in custody since 27.12.2018, has renewed his prayer for bail in connection with Nadi Thana P.S. Case No. 269 of 2018, Special Case No. 148 of 2018, having earlier been rejected by order dated 10.09.2020 in Cr. Misc. No.21509 of 2020 for the alleged offences under Sections

20, 22, 25, 29 of NDPS Act and Section 120B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he was the driver of the seized truck from which 562 kilogram of ganja was recovered. It is submitted that the petitioner has already suffered custody since 27.12.2018.

5. Having heard the parties, this Court is not inclined to take a different view in the matter of granting bail to the petitioner at this stage. The petition stands dismissed.

6. Office shall follow-up to ensure that all defects are removed and compliance with the notices of this Court are made by the petitioner within the stipulated time provided in para 2 hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
