2 15-12-2021 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Gayghat P.S. Case No. 144 of 2021 for the offence registered
under Sections 30(a), 36, 37(b) and 41(1) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

The allegation is regarding recovery of 5 litres of
illicit liquor and 50 litres of sweet Mahua mixture from the
house of the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent, has been falsely implicated in the
present case, is having a clean antecedent and she is languishing
in custody since 05.04.2021.

Per contra, the learned counsel for the State has



vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and taking into account the materials available on record as also considering the period of incarceration of the petitioner herein, I deem it fit and proper to direct for release of the petitioner herein on regular bail.

Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Muzaffarpur in connection with Gayghat P.S. Case No. 144 of 2021.
