after complete start of the physical Court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned  
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case  
registered for the offences punishable under Sections  
147/148/149/341/323/324/307/379/427/504506 of the Indian  
Penal Code.

Specific allegation of commission of injury at the  
head of the informant is against co-accused Nand Lal Sahani  
and Pradeep Sahni. The petitioner and others bear general and  
omnibus allegation.

Submission is that the petitioner has got no criminal  
antecedent and co-accused Pramod Sahani bearing identical



allegation has already been allowed anticipatory bail by a coordinate Bench of this Court vide order at Annexure-2.

Considering the submission aforesaid, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Gaighat P.S. Case No.275 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
