2 18-03-2021 Heard Mr. Anil Prasad Singh, learned counsel
for the petitioner and Mr. Satyendra Narain Singh,
learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his
arrest in connection with Raniganj P.S. Case No. 186 of
2020 dated 26.04.2020 instituted for the offences under
Sections 147, 149, 188, 341, 323, 325 and 353 of the
Indian Penal Code read with Section 51 of the National
Disaster Management Act of 2005 and Section 3 of the
Epidemic Diseases Act, 1987.

After some arguments, Mr. Anil Prasad Singh,
learned Advocate for the petitioner seeks permission to
withdraw this petition in order to enable the petitioner to
surrender before the court below and seek bail.

The prayer is allowed.



The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty to him to approach the court below for grant of bail. Should such a petition be filed, the court below shall consider all the aspects in totality and shall pass orders in accordance with law without being prejudiced by the fact that the present petition has not been entertained.
