for the State as well as learned counsel for the complainant.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Supaul Complaint Case No. 994C of 2017 for offences
under Sections 323. 504 and 498A of the Indian Penal Code.

Under these circumstances, let petitioner, above-
named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks

Supaul in connection with Supaul Complaint Case No. 994C of
2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section
438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
