The petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated

23.05.2018 passed by the Commandant, 26 Battalion,

C.R.P.F, Bokaro, Jharkhand whereby the petitioner has

been removed from the service on the ground of

unauthorized absence from the duty.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the

remedy by way of an appeal to the authority concerned.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed off with a direction to the petitioner to approach the appropriate Appellate Authority.
