The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection

that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the

present case. There is general and omnibus allegation against

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State and

opposed the prayer of the petitioner by contending that petitioner is the husband of the opposite party no. 2. Further submission is that after due undertaking given by the petitioner before this Court vide order dated 06.11.2019, the petitioner has not kept his wife with full honour and dignity and again he is alleged to have assaulted and tortured his wife. Hence, this is not a fit case of anticipatory bail.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
