2 02-11-2021 At the outset, petitioner is permitted to make
correction in paragraph 3 of the bail petition during course of
the day.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner seeks regular bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a)/47(2) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

As per the prosecution case, 2 liters of country made
liquor was recovered from the house of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. No incriminating material has been recovered from the
conscious possession of the petitioner and he is no way
concerned with the alleged recovery as the house in question is



the joint family property. Petitioner is in custody since 27.3.2021. Investigation is complete.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the rival submissions of the parties, materials available on the record and the period of custody of the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge II cum Special Judge, Excise Act Gaya in Kothi Police Station Case No. 09 of 2021.
