2 02-11-2021 The present writ petition has been filed for quashing the decision of the District Level Selection Committee headed by the District Magistrate, Muzaffarpur (Annexure-2 to the present writ petition) whereby and whereunder the Private Respondent No. 10 has been selected instead of



the petitioner herein although the father-in-law of the Respondent No. 10 is already a PDS dealer.

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be preferring an appeal before the learned Divisional Commissioner, Tirhut Division, Muzaffarpur, hence, the learned Divisional Commissioner, Tirhut Division, Muzaffarpur, be directed to consider the appeal / revision of the petitioner and dispose it of expeditiously.

The learned counsel for the Respondent-State, Sri Alok Ranjan (AC to AAG-5), has got no objection.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to prefer appropriate appeal / revision against the decision of the District Level Selection Committee headed by the District Magistrate, Muzaffarpur and in case, appropriate appeal / revision is filed within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be considered on merits and disposed of in accordance with law, by a reasoned and a



speaking order within a period of eight weeks,
thereafter.
