ORAL ORDER

2 08-01-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State. Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed an undertaking to remove all defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter as and when required. It is accordingly directed that all defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter be removed within one month hereof.

2. The petitioner is in custody since 22.06.2020 in connection with Vibhutipur P.S. Case No. 137 of 2020 for the alleged offences under Sections 307, 323, 341, 354, 447, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in connection with committing assault on the informant with pagharia (hasua) on his head. It is submitted that the parties are agnates and neighbours of each other and the dispute arose over passage. It is submitted that in any event the injury is simple in nature. The petitioner has already suffered more than six months in custody and claims clean antecedents.

4. Learned APP appears and has been heard.



5. Be that as it may and having regard to the period of custody already suffered since 22.06.2020, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate II, Rosera, Samastipur in connection with Vibhutipur P.S. Case No. 137 of 2020, if he is not otherwise required in any other case.

6. Office shall follow-up to ensure that all defects are removed and compliance with the notices of this Court are made by the petitioner within the stipulated time provided in para 1 hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
