2 20-12-2021 Let the defects, if any, be removed within four weeks
after complete start of the physical Court.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Section 380 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Suspicion is that the petitioner and co-worker, who
were working as painter in the house of the informant, removed
the laptop of the informant. The petitioner has got no criminal
antecedent.

Since only material is suspicion and petitioner has
stated that just to pressurize the petitioner not to ask for due
wages false case has been lodged.



Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Mithanpura P.S. Case No. 185 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.

(c) The petitioner shall not leave the country without permission of the trial Court.
