ORAL ORDER

3 27-01-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State. Learned counsel for the petitioner hereby undertakes to remove all defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter as and when required. It is accordingly directed that all defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter be removed within one month hereof.

2. The petitioner is in custody since 22.05.2020 in connection with Madanpur P.S. Case No. 26 of 2020 for the alleged offences under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in connection with alleged withdrawals made from the bank account of the informant to the tune of Rs. 5,01,604.47. It is submitted that the petitioner's name has transpired on the statement of one Kundan Kumar, C.S.P. of the Allahabad Bank with ulterior motive. It is submitted that in any event the petitioner could not possibly have withdrawn the amount from the informant's bank account on the basis of Aadhar card. There is undue delay in lodging the FIR on 06.02.2020 for the alleged occurrence of 13.01.2020. The petitioner claims clean



antecedents.

4. Learned APP appears and has been heard. He points out from para 3 of the case diary that majority of the withdrawals are said to have been made by Kundan Kumar. No objective adverse material against the petitioner has been pointed out in this regard.

5. Be that as it may and having regard to the period of custody already suffered since 22.05.2020, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad in connection with Madanpur P.S. Case No. 26 of 2020, if he is not otherwise required in any other case.

6. Office shall follow-up to ensure that all defects are removed and compliance with the notices of this Court are made by the petitioner within the stipulated time provided in para 1 hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
