2 27-01-2021 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

APP for the State. Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed an
undertaking to remove all the defects pointed out by the Stamp
Reporter as and when required. It is accordingly directed that all
defects pointed out by the Stamp Reporter be removed within
one month hereof.

2. The petitioner is in custody since 25.08.2020 in
connection with Mali P.S. Case No. 100 of 2020 for the alleged
offences under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act, 2018.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely
implicated in connection with recovery of 238.5 litres of
country-made liquor. The petitioner denies recovery of the
offending goods from his conscious possession. In any event,



the petitioner has already suffered about five months in custody, and claims clean antecedents.

4. Learned APP appears and has been heard.

5. Be that as it may and having regard to the period of custody already suffered since 25.08.2020, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII-cum-Special Judge (Excise), Aurangabad, in connection with Mali P.S. Case No. 100 of 2020, if he is not otherwise required in any other case.

6. Office shall follow-up to ensure that all defects are removed and compliance with the notices of this Court are made by the petitioner within the stipulated time provided in para 1 hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
