The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered under Sections 399, 402, 412 of the Indian Penal
Code and Sections 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

Allegation is that the accused persons gathered to
commit dacoity and upon seeing police party they fled away and
some accused persons were caught and upon search a country
made katta, a live cartridge and a mobile was recovered from
the possession of accused Balwant Singh and a country made
pistol and a live cartridge and a motorcycle was recovered from

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. The name of the petitioner has come on confessional statement of co-accused. There is no recovery of arms from the possession of the petitioner.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra in connection with Chapra Muffasil P.S. case No.50 of 2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
