ORAL ORDER

5 24-07-2021 The matter has been taken up for hearing online because of COVID-19 pandemic restrictions.

This is an application seeking direction to Respondent No. 5 to allow operation of the bank account of Shankar Dayal Singh Inter College, Jalalpur, which is a privately managed educational institution. There are intervention applications filed on behalf of the private persons.



On the basis of pleadings on record, it is evident that there is serious dispute in respect of management over the said Shankar Dayal Singh Inter College, Jalalpur involving disputed questions of facts. Such disputed questions of fact cannot be gone into in a proceeding under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

This application is accordingly dismissed with a liberty to the parties to approach the appropriate forum in accordance with law for resolution of dispute.

All interlocutory applications stand disposed of.
