Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are mother and sister of the deceased who apprehend their arrest in connection with Shahpur Patory P.S. Case No. 22/2020, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302/201/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The F.I.R. was registered by the wife of the deceased against her mother-in-law and sister-in-law. Subsequently, the informant has filed an affidavit in court below stating that F.I.R. has been wrongly lodged by her and the petitioners are not involved in the death of their own son and brother.

In these circumstances, the petitioners deserve



anticipatory bail.

Let the petitioners above named be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. 4th, Samastipur in connection with Shahpur Patory P.S. Case No. 22/2020, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
