2 27-09-2021 The present writ petition has been filed seeking a direction upon the District Level Selection Committee-cum-Collector, Muzaffarpur to select the petitioner in place of respondent no. 6 for the purposes of grant of PDS license.

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be approaching the Divisional Commissioner, Muzaffarpur for redressal of his aforesaid grievances under Rule 32(vi) of the Bihar Targeted PDS (Control) Order, 2016.
