2 16-11-2021 Petitioner has prayed for the following relief(s):

“(I) For a direction to the Respondents to issue the Award of R.O. Dealership in favour of the Petitioner at within 5 KM from Mohania Railway Over Bridge on Mohania Bhabhua Road in the District of Kaimur Advertised on 25.11.2018.

(II) For a direction to the Respondents to complete the formalities if any, within short time and Award R.O. Dealership to the Petitioner since the Petitioner has been selected successful candidate after completing



all formalities.

(III) For any other relief/reliefs for which the Petitioner is entitled for in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

Undisputedly, during the pendency of the present petition, the process for selection and appointment of the dealer stands cancelled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner alleges that the endeavour is only to defeat the petitioner’s right inasmuch as thrice the process was cancelled.

Be that as it may, insofar as the present petition is concerned, it has become infructuous.

As such, the petition is disposed of, reserving liberty to the petitioner to initiate appropriate proceedings, if so required and desired, assailing the subsequent action taken by the respondents.

Interlocutory application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
