2 21-12-2021 Let the defect (s) be removed within two weeks of
the complete start of the physical Court.

Heard the parties.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304B/34
of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioners are mother-in-law and younger brother of
the husband of the victim of dowry death. Husband of the victim
is already in jail.

Submission is that the allegation is general and
omnibus and the petitioners are victim of over implication. The
victim might have committed suicide due to quarrel with her
husband.



Considering the submission aforesaid, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000 (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Katihar Muffasil P.S.Case No.41 of 2021, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as subject to the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court below.

(b) The petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.

(c) The petitioners shall not leave the country without permission of the learned Trial Court.
