the petitioner and Mr. Md. Nadim Seraj, learned counsel for the  
L.N. Mithila University, Darbhanga through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed the present writ application  
for a direction to the respondent - University for payment of  
retiral dues i.e. pension, gratuity, arrears of salary etc.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that  
petitioner has retired from the post of Reader, Sanskrit  
Department, M.R.M. College, Darbhanga. Learned counsel  
further submits that this writ application may be disposed of  
with a direction to the Vice Chancellor, L.N. Mithila University  
to consider the representation of the petitioner and dispose of



the same in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the University has got no objection.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, the petitioner is permitted to file a fresh and detailed representation raising his claim before respondent no. 1 i.e. Vice Chancellor, L.N. Mithila University, Darbhanga within a period of one month from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order and the Vice Chancellor is further directed to consider and dispose of the representation filed by the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the representation.

Needless to say that if any amount is found payable to the petitioner, the same shall be paid by the respondent -University to the petitioner within a further period of two months from the date of disposal of the representation.

With the aforesaid observation and direction, this writ petition is disposed of.
