Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State through video conference.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has filed an
undertaking that all defects pointed out by the stamp reporter
shall be removed, and compliance with the conditions of the
notices of this Court with regard to acceptance of e-filing shall be
made, without delay immediately upon resumption of normal
physical functioning of the Court, and in any event within one
month thereof.

3. The petitioner, who is in custody since
19.07.2018, has renewed his prayer for bail in connection with
Saraiya (Jaitpur O.P.) P.S. Case No. 81 of 2013, having earlier been
rejected by order dated 04.12.2019 passed in Criminal
Miscellaneous No. 55823 of 2019 for the offence alleged under



Sections 498A, 323, 304B, 506 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner reiterates his earlier submission to the effect that the petitioner has been implicated merely because he happens to be the husband of the deceased and that his wife died owing to burn injury suffered during cooking.

5. Learned APP appears and has been heard.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, in the absence of any material change in circumstance, this Court is not inclined to take a different view of the matter for grant of bail to the petitioner. The petition, accordingly, stands dismissed.

7. Office shall follow-up to ensure that all defects are removed and compliance with the notices of this Court are made by the petitioner within the stipulated time provided in para-2 hereinabove, failing which the matter shall be brought to the notice of this Court.
